

Student Password Reset

At Aberfoyle Park High School, your password protected user account allows you access to a number of services, including wifi/internet, Daymap and email.

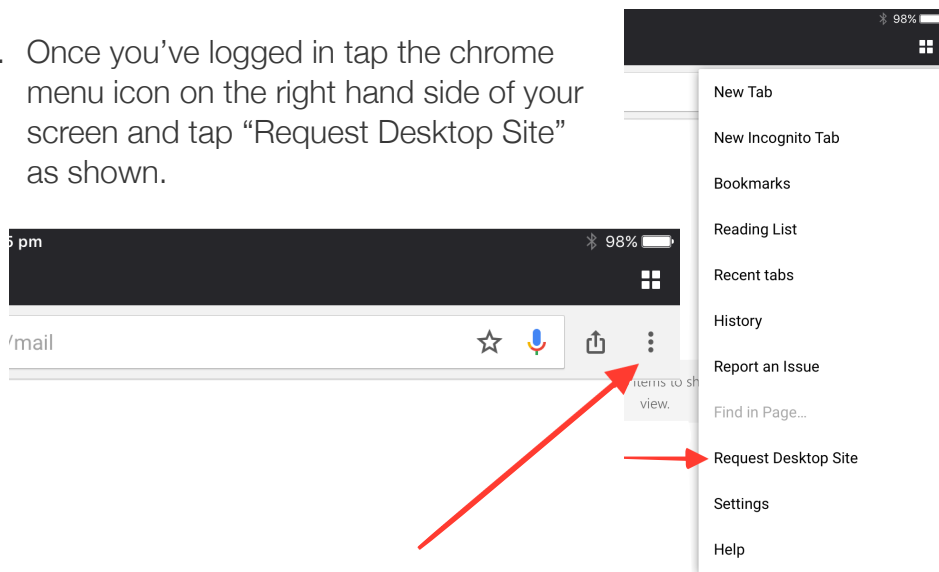
To reset your password on an iPad, you will need Google Chrome web browser. If you don't already have this, you can download it for free from the App Store.

1. Open any web browser on your laptop, or Google Chrome on your iPad, and go to

<https://webmail.aphs.sa.edu.au/owa>

2. Login with your username and password. If you are on a laptop you can skip steps 3 and 4.

3. Once you've logged in tap the chrome menu icon on the right hand side of your screen and tap "Request Desktop Site" as shown.



4. Once you've selected that, refresh the page with the icon next to the address bar.

5. Click/Tap on the settings gear icon, then change password as shown to the right.
6. You will be asked to provide your current password and then enter your new password twice.

Enter your current password, type a new password, and then type it again to confirm it.

After saving, you might need to re-enter your user name and password and sign in again. You'll be notified when your password has been changed successfully.

It's a good idea to use strong passwords that are at least eight characters long, and combine uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols.

7. Once you have done that, it will return you to the login screen for Outlook Web Access, indicating that your password change has been successful.

Now that you've changed your password, don't forget when you sign in to any school service like wifi/internet, Daymap, email, etc, you will need to use your new password.
